

ORDINANCE NO. 03-2022

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RISING STAR, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING NO PARKING ON US 183 FROM THE NORTH CITY LIMITS OF RISING STAR TO THE SOUTH CITY LIMITS OF RISING STAR ON BOTH SIDES OF THE ROAD, EXCEPT FOR THE FOLLOWING AREAS: PARKING IS ALLOWED ON WEST SIDE OF US 183 IN FRONT OF RISING STAR HIGH SCHOOL; PARKING IS ALLOWED ON WEST SIDE OF US 183 FROM DILL STREET TO W. GIBSON STREET; PARKING IS ALLOWED FROM EAST MILLS TO EAST SMITH ON BOTH SIDES; ESTABLISHING NO PARKING ON HIGHWAY 36/COLLEGE STREET FROM MILLER STREET TO MAYBEN STREET ON BOTH SIDES OF THE ROAD; AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING STAFF TO PLACE PROPER SIGNAGE INDICATING THE NO PARKING ZONES; PROVIDING A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) FOR CONVICTION OF ANY VIOLATION THEREOF; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RISING STAR, TEXAS, that the following locations be established as NO Parking zones:

No Parking on US 183 (“183”) from the North City limits of Rising Star to the South City limits of Rising Star to the South City limits of Rising Star on both sides of 183, except for the following areas: parking is allowed on the West side of 183 in front of the Rising Star High School; parking is allowed on the West side of 183 from Dill Street to W. Gibson Street; parking is allowed from East Mills to East Smith on both sides.

No Parking on Highway 36/College Street from Miller Street to Mayben Street on both sides of the road.

AUTHORIZING PROPER SIGNAGE: City staff shall be authorized and directed to place proper signage indicating the *No Parking* zones.


PENALTY: Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, fined in an amount not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00).

SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: If any section, subsection, phrase, sentence, or portion of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holdings shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SAVINGS CLAUSE: All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed. The balance of such ordinance is hereby saved from repeal.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final passage and publication as required by law, and installation of proper signs.
